Which expression unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof includes heirs, Executors, and administrators, etc., whereas settler of the trust is possessed of and otherwise well and sufficiently entitled to the sum of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) hereinafter referred to as said property. Whereas the following persons are trustees in trust for the purposes detailed in this Trust Deed:

Trust will be a platform for social awareness for all citizens as well as govt to progress in rational thinking and presenting logical ideas for achieving human development and achieving mutual harmony among all Indian citizens without any profit-making motive or to have any other form of gain by doing so. These objects and purposes are expressed in this trust deed under clause 2 of this deed.

NOW THIS DEED OF DECLARATION WITNEESETH:


**1. THE NAME OF THE TRUST SHALL "CHETNA SMILE TRUST"**

THE TRUST OFFICE PRESENTLY SHALL BE AT-SULTANPUR PALNAPUR, FARRUKHABAD, UTTAR PRADESH- 207505. However, the trustees may change it from time to time on the basis of majority decision. The term Trustee shall mean the trustees of the said "CHETNA SMILE TRUST"

**AREA OF OPERATION:** - The area of operation of trust shall be all India level.



**OBJECTS / GUIDELINES OF THE TRUST ARE:**

The main trust area of activities and objectives of the Trust shall be to serve the society at large by making available a platform to citizens at grass root level where they can share promote their ideas to public at large & govt. Trust will contribute to nation by promoting traditional cultural indigenous education ethnic way of life & promoting problem solving ideas in education, economic & cultural sector. Trust will be a platform for social awareness for all citizens as well as govt to progress in rational thinking and presenting logical ideas for achieving human development and achieving mutual harmony among all Indian citizens without any profit-making motive or to have any other form of gain by doing so... Without affecting the generality of the above-mentioned objectives, the specific objectives to be achieved and activities to be undertaken are:



20. To accept gifts, donations, grants, present and other offerings and deal with the same for the use of the trust.
21. To provide and distribute food packets, clothing and drinking water for hunger people in rural and remote areas.
22. To organize awareness programmes, health camps, workshop, and exhibition.
23. To communicate and coordinate with Govt. local and public authorities on various issues related to development, welfare and public interest on different subjects.
24. To arrange and organize religious, social, and cultural programmes for all human beings from time to time.
25. To promote and protect natural herbs and plants by cultivation, preservation, storage, processing, and necessary training.
26. To provide a healthy environment by providing tree plantation on the roadside, park, river waste land and other various places in all over India level.
27. All the activities of the Trust shall be non-profitable and shall be done on a "no profit-no loss" basis.

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## EDUCATION

- a) Develop model education system in rural and urban areas.
- b) Provide technical and technological education.
- c) To provide and conduct vocational training courses like Tourism, IT, Office management, Jan Swasthya, cultural program, paramedical, etc. by way of various courses which are relevant to current time through well qualified, experienced, and professional teachers.
- d) To Start, establish, run, takeover or manage and maintain Schools, College, Universities, Polytechnic Institutes and Like, with an object to provide primary, Middle, Secondary, higher, Undergraduate and Post Graduate education to students by seeking recognition.
- e) To organized, conduct & confern the qualification, certificates, diploma, pg. diploma ug degree, pg. degree & all other courses by regular mode, non-regular mode, on demand mode, distance education mode.
- f) Paramedical certificates, diploma, PG diploma, UG degree, M.Phil. courses in- Medical Laboratory Technology, Radiation Technology, Operation Theater Technology, Dialysis Technology, Orthopedic, Dental Mechanics, Dental Hygiene, Cath Lab Technology, Nursing Administration, Perfusion Technology, Hospital Management etc.
- g) Management Certificate, Diploma, PG Diploma, UG Degree, M.Phil. courses in- Banking Finance, Business Administration in Banking, Human Resources/Telecommunication etc.
- h) To establish computer education in India by way of various computer course which are relevant to the current time through qualified, experienced teachers and professionals enable the student to become self-dependent and which job oriented.
- i) To organise and undertake and develop Educational Institutions for needy, poor, and underserved wherever and whenever necessary.
- j) To mobilize and organise the rural community in awareness and general education for development activities.
- k) To motivate and train communities about practicability and utility of Appropriate Technology and upgrade their capacity and skills.
- l) To establish an educational institution, maintain and run a boarding house, residential for the students and those connected with the institutions into other branches as per Govt. rules.
- m) Work towards upliftment and empowerment of poor, marginalized, and underserved.



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- n) To help the rural innocent people in all activities and make them to participate in all existing Government programmes through our charitable activities.
- o) To arrange training camps and workshops by famous Speakers and experts involved in the respective forms of business and profession to create interest and motivate the younger generation.
- p) To provide a platform for young professionals/students to expose their knowledge in the market.
- q) To admit students for various discipline and subjects and for courses offered by the institution run by this trust and to offer scholarships to the deserving and/ or economically backward students.
- r) To promote and establish study center all over India of teacher training courses, hardware and networking courses, paramedical courses along with CMS and ED (Community Medical Service & Essential Drugs) and many other vocational courses.
- s) Trust will open/manage or maintain medical colleges /schools/institutes to provide diploma/certificate in medical courses and also provide facilities like scholarships to do internship from any college/institute or university in India.

#### HEALTH:

- a) To provide medical relief for poor and needy people.
- b) To arrange and provide medical aid and other assistance necessary for living to the needy people who are incapable or handicapped or mentally/physically retarded and financially unfit.
- c) To establish, build or manage Hostels, Short Stay Homes, Rehabilitation Centers, Shelters, Crèches, Child Care Centre or Children's Home, Counseling Centers and Help Line Centers for Women, Children, Old aged persons, Drug addicts and needy persons.
- d) To organize medical health care centers and organize medicine distribution camps among the poor and needy peoples of urban and rural areas all India level.
- e) To provide medical facilities for deserving children of the rural locality.
- f) To make adequate arrangements to start drug addiction centers for social evils, drug habitual, psychological, physical, and mental people.
- g) To provide, conduct, assist, encourage, initiate, or promote all type of research facilities for carrying on the research, discovery, improvement, or development of new methods of diagnosis.

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- h) To fight against HIV/AIDS and other communicable diseases through different medico Schemes.
- i) Establishment, conduct, maintenance of clinical laboratories, hospitals, nursing homes, dispensaries and institutions of similar nature and providing financial assistance to the deserving persons for medical treatment, in any medical institution.

**ENVIRONMENT:**

- a) To provide healthy environment by providing tree plantation on the side roads, parks, street, fields, river waste land, and rocky tracks all over India level.
- b) To support and promote the growing of trees and drilling of bore wells, restoration of water tanks, taking up drinking water projects, water development programs and providing of space and rooms for conducting religious functions or any other allied activities as the trustees deem fit from time to time.
- c) Facilitate information sharing with local communities affected by unsustainable development.
- d) work with local communities to both capacitate and share information so they are in a better position to make informed decisions about their local environment and livelihoods; and support local communities to enable them to participate meaningfully in public participation meetings related to projects taking place in their own areas.
- e) Advocate for environmental and social justice by forming alliances with other NGOs, CBOs and affected communities, and by identifying and working with relevant organizations, decision-makers, government agencies and environmental attorneys to challenge injustices and non-compliance with legislation.
- f) Support the growing movement that realizes the importance of the Environment, open spaces, natural areas, and agricultural land. Faced with the threats of climate change and predicted disasters, communities able to feed themselves will be more resilient. SA must feed itself; it is important to encourage and support farms to remain a food source and not sell to developers
- g) Create an Education Plan to assist people make better decisions regarding conservation and as a support mechanism for building conservation-based policies, value systems and creating sustainable and environmentally sound Public- Private Partnerships with government.


### **RELIGIOUS**

- a) To establish, conduct and manage Lord Ram Temple, Lord Shiva, and another God Temple in various place.
- b) To promote Hindu religious books like the Vedas, the Ramayana, and the Bhagwat Gita.
- c) To create an atmosphere favorable to moral and spiritual growth.
- d) To preach and propagate the Sanatan Dharma on the basis of the Vedantas.
- e) This trust plays an extraordinary role in protection, preservation, and nurturing of Hindu culture.
- f) To maintain, manage, conduct Ashram by providing shelters to the needy and deserving child, women and widows and educate them about small scale industry, cottage industry with a view to earn their livelihood.
- g) To promote and celebrate religious festival and tradition like Dasher, Diwali, Ram Navami etc.
- h) To spread the messages of preserving and conserving the Indian culture and save the same from influence of the western cultures throughout India and in all foreign countries.
- i) To arrange and organize religious, social, and cultural programmes for all human being from time to time.
- j) Regular public worship, preaching and teaching.
- k) To Identify Such Historical, Cultural and Spiritual/Religious Places of Ancient India, Known as Symbols of Social Integrity and To Work for their Protection and Conservation.
- l) To act as an institution for the promotion of Gaushalas, an infrastructure for providing relief and aid and a quality lifestyle to the cows through foods, shelters, and open land areas for their natural living wherever such infrastructures/services are required with a motive to protect the cows.
- m) To provide the how services to others who are engaged for the Gau Sewa or any other related services which may be decided by the board of trustees from time to time.

### **OTHER SOCIAL WELFARE ACTIVITIES:**


- a) The Charitable trust will undertake works related to research, training, production, marketing, workshop, seminars, conference on education, health, social justice, women and

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- child, textiles, agriculture, rural development of handicrafts, handloom, khadi & other village industry etc.
- b) To take up effective, reasonable, and lawful steps for the eradication of social evils such as dowry system, child marriage, child labour, wastage of money in various functions and use of intoxicated drugs/wine/smoking etc.
  - c) To help the poor and indigent persons in marriage of their daughters and son by way of cash donations or otherwise and to distribute cloths, foods, and other necessities of daily life among the poor's, orphans, and other indigent persons.
  - d) To approach and encourage the people to donate, dhotis, blankets, woolen, cotton silk cloths and other article of daily use to the needy men, women, and children.
  - e) To work for the development of st/sc people across the country.
  - f) To conduct training and research programmes for pollution control (in water, air, atmosphere, disease due to pollution and to maintain, develop and protest
  - g) forests, environment, and species of the kingdoms of life. (Animals, birds, plants, herbs etc.) wild-life and other natural gifts helping to support the preservation of environment.
  - h) To manage and Implement all Governmental and Non-Governmental Schemes Meant for Human Welfare.
  - i) To help poor, widows, handicapped, orphans, old aged, mentally retarded and under privileged section of the trust/community.
  - j) To Create Awareness and Implement Health and Family Welfare and To Organize Awareness Movement for Population Control.
  - k) To make common people aware of various projects and schemes launched by human resources development and social welfare department and aide them to avail benefit of these schemes and projects.
  - l) To work for the empowerment and sensitization of women, adolescents, and children.
  - m) To create a sense of brotherhood, love, humanity, affection, cooperation, and friendship amongst the members of the trust and the beneficiaries.
  - n) To promote traditional therapies like Yoga, Naturopathy, Meditation, Acupressure, Acupuncture, Massage Therapy, Ayurveda, Homeopathy, Reiki etc.
  - o) To accept donations grants, presents and offerings, in cash or in kind from persons, association of persons, firms, companies, institutions, universities in India & abroad and to deal with the same for the purpose of achieving the objects of the trust mentioned above upon such terms and conditions as trustees may think fit and consistent with the objects of the trust.
  - p) To Identify Such Historical, Cultural and Spiritual/Religious Places of Ancient India, Known as Symbols of Social Integrity and To Work for Their Protection and Conservation.
  - q) Trust will celebrate annual day of the trust every year as cultural and social event.
  - r) To Celebrate of National and international days and conduct Sports, yoga class event in summer days.
  - s) To Celebrate National Festivals, Freedom Fighters / Leaders Birthdays, State Festival, and other common festivals.

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- t) To give donations/fodder/shelters or any other kind of help to Gaushalas.

All the activities of the Trust shall be non-profitable and shall be done on a "no profit - no loss" basis.

The Trustees hereby transfer the sum of Rs. 1, 000/- (Rupees One thousand only) each in favour of the Trust. The above said amount shall be their initial contribution. The Trustees shall hold the said fund and other properties that may be endowed or conferred for the said Trust for the use and benefit of the Trust. The Trustees shall, out of the income realized from the properties endowed and such other endowments or donations, which they may get, pay all taxes and rates, where applicable, and all expenditure connected with the trust. Where such income is insufficient to meet the expenses, the trustees may use such portion of the corpus of the Trust fund for the purpose, as may be found necessary and where the income of the Trust exceeds the expenditure of the Trust, such excess may be added to the Trust fund.

**4. BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

(a) The Board of Trustees shall comprise the founding Trustees. The founding Trustees shall hold Office for life. However, any trustee may resign by giving notice in writing to his/ her co trustees. Appointment of trustees, either to fill up a vacancy or as additional trustees, shall be by resolution of the founding trustees.

(b) The trustees hereby declare that they for time being, We hold the said sum and all gifts, contribution, subscription, donations, bequests and other moneys or property as and when the same shall be paid to or vested with them as the moneys, investment and property from time to time representing the same upon trust of object of general public utility not involving the carrying of any activity for the profit or for charitable purposes which tends to promote human welfare, providing however no part of the funds or income thereof be applied to any purpose outside India except in accordance with the approval with Central Board of Revenue, government of India and for such purpose, as defined in objects clause (2) above.

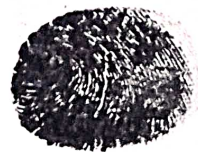

## 5. POWER & DUTIES OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES

- (a). To apply, the whole or part of the income or accumulation thereof or whole or part of the corpus of the Trust properties for one or more of the objects of the Trust as outlined in clause (2) above or as the Trustees may from time to time determine.
- (b.) To convert and get in the Trust property and/ or vary the investments for the time being and to invest and keep invest the Trust properties either in the purchase or mortgage of immovable properties or in shares, debentures, or other securities/ investments and to alter, vary or transpose such investment from time to time as the Trustees, shall in their absolute discretion think fit. Provided, however, that accumulations of the income of the Trust properties, in respect of which notice has been given to the assessing officer under section 11(2)(a) of the Income-Tax Act 1961, shall only be invested in accordance with section 11(2)(b) the Act.
- (c.) To let or demise any immovable property comprised in the trust fund for such rent, on such terms and conditions, as the trustees in their absolute discretion shall think fit. To open account in the name of the Trust, with any Bank or Banks and to operate such accounts and to give instructions to the bank and to provide for opening and operation of such account by one or more of the Trustees or any one or more agents appointed by the Trustees.
- (d). To adjust, settle, compromise, compound, and refer to arbitration all actions, suits claim, demands and proceedings regarding the trust properties.
- (e). To appoint constituted attorneys or agents and to delegate to such attorney or agents all or any of the powers vested in them under these presents from time to time and remove such attorneys or agents and to appoint other or others in his or their place.
- (f). To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any persons (including all or any of the Trustees) as committee or administrator or managing Trustee or otherwise for the purpose of the administration of the trust, in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the Trustees may prescribe.
- (g). To make, vary, alter, or modify schemes, rules, and regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and of running any institutions in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects to the Trust.
- (h). To set apart to whole or part of the income or the corpus or part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust.

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(i). The Trustees shall be chargeable only for such moneys, stocks, shares and funds, as shall actually come into their hands and shall not be answerable for neglect, default, acts of omission or commission of the other Trustees or of any banker or default, acts of omission or commission of the other Trustees or of any banker or other person with whom, the Trust properties and securities may have been deposited or handed over, unless caused by their will full neglect or Defaults'.

(j). The receipt of a person authorized by the Trustees or a resolution of the Board of Trustees for any moneys paid, or any property transferred or delivered to Trustees in execution of the Trust or powers.


(k). thereof or for the purchase moneys of any property authorized to be sold, shall effectually discharge any person or persons so paying or transferring or delivering.

(l). The Trustees will not be entitled to receive any remuneration as Trustees but may reimburse themselves of all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the Trust or their duties thereto.


(m). No Trustee shall refuse to be Chairman of the Board of Trustees unless he/she shows his resentment to act as Chairman for a specified or unlimited duration. The Chairman shall be entitled to call the meeting of the Board of Trustees and preside over the meeting. The Board of Trustees may from time to time frame all other rules for the conduct of the administration of the Trust and regulating the meeting of Trustees, which are not covered in this deed. In the absence of such regulations: Majority will decide all matters and two Trustees shall form a quorum for meeting of Board of Trustees. Resolution passed without any meeting of the Board of Trustees and evidenced in writing under the hand of two thirds of the Trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a resolution duly passed at a meeting of the Board of Trustees.

(n) Proper Books & Accounts shall be maintained by the Trust and shall be audited by an independent firm of chartered accountants.

(o) The Trustees shall maintain the minutes book, in which the proceedings of all meetings of Trustees shall be recorded by the Trustees and the Chairman of the meeting shall sign the same.









## 6. CUSTODY OF DOCUMENTS

The Chairman or his/her nominee or any other Trustee, if so, authorized by the Board of Trustees, shall have the custody of all the documents, deeds of title, relating to the Trust properties and investment, and the books of account and the other record relating to the Trust and shall be responsible for the preservation of the same.

## 7. ADVISORY BODY AND CONSULTANT

The Trustee may maintain a set of Advisors for thereof utilizing their services in furtherance of the objects of the trust.

## 8. FINANCIAL YEAR

The financial year of the Trust shall end on 31st March every year provided that the Board of Trustees shall be at liberty to change the same from time to time if they so deem fit and proper. Trust account should be audited by certified chartered account every financial year.

## 9. BANK ACCOUNT OPERATION

The Bank A/c. of Trust shall be operated by the Author or any of the other trustees jointly duly authorized by Board

## 10. ACCOUNTABILITY OF THE TRUSTEES



The Trustees, without prejudice to any other statutory or other right to indemnification that they may have, shall be jointly and severally indemnified out of the Trust Fund at all times in respect of each and every claim made against them or any of them whether in their capacity as Trustee or Trustees or personally in respect of any liability arising from or in respect of the Trust, its affairs, administration or activities or any aspect of any

of the same provided always that the right of a Trustee to an indemnity under this clause shall not extend to any claim arising from wilful fraud or wrongdoing or wrongful omission or commission on his part.

## 11. INDEMNITY OF TRUSTEES

(a) The Trustees may reimburse themselves and pay and discharge out of the Trust Fund all Expenses incurred by them in or about the execution of the Trust as specifically authorized by the Trust in the meeting of the Trustees, or any of their duties under these presents including travelling expenses but will not be entitled to receive any remuneration for the services to be rendered by them as Trustees. The expenses incurred by them in this regard will be

reimbursed to them only if the same are approved in a meeting of the Board of Trustees.

(b) The Trustees shall be accountable only for such moneys, contributions and funds as shall actually come into their hands and a Trustee shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect, default, acts or omission or commission of the other Trustees, nor of any banker or other person with whom the Trust properties or any securities may have been deposited or kept for furtherance of any one or more of the objects of the Trust.

## **12. UTILIZATION OF TRUST PROPERTY**

If the income from the Trust property in a particular year is not fully utilized, the unspent income, subject to the applicable provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961, shall be carried over to the next year or years and spent in such subsequent year or years for achieving the objects of the Trust.

## **13. BENEFITS OF THE TRUST**

The Benefits of the Trust activities in terms of the educational, training, and related services it provides shall be available to all Indians, irrespective of caste, creed, age, sex, or religion.

## **14. ADDITIONS TO THE CORPUS**

The Trust Fund may be added to, by the income from the initial fund and also by donations and other contributions from time to time.

## **15. DISSOLUTION OF TRUST**

The Trust may be dissolved by mutual and voluntary agreement of the Trustees. No force or coercion shall be brought about by a Trustee to bear upon the other Trustee(s) for the purpose of bringing about dissolution of the Trust. On dissolution of the Trust, all the properties and other funds of The Trust whether with the Trustees or anywhere else shall be either utilized in full for the object of the trust or shall be vested in some other Trust or any other form of public charitable organization having similar objects.

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**16. IRREVOCABILITY**

It is declared that the Trust is irrevocable. If the Trust fails for any reason, in the opinion of the Trustees, the net assets of the Trust, both movable and unmovable shall be handed over to any Trust having the same object, as decided by the majority of the Trustees.

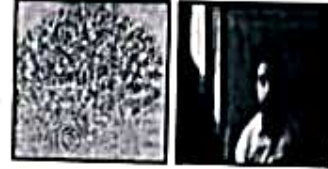
